Policy: Transportation
Windsor Southwest Supervisory Union

Where it is reasonably necessary, the School Districts of the Windsor Southwest Supervisory Union will furnish transportation on public roads to students who reside within the school district communities. The district may provide transportation to non resident students as authorized by the school board.

Implementation

The principals will establish routes and designate stops after considering both the safety of children and efficiency of operation. The principals will consider the following factors when determining routes and stops.

1. The age and health of pupils,
2. Distance to be traveled,
3. Condition of the road, and
4. Type of highway.

The principals may consider any other factors he or she deems appropriate when establishing routes and designated stops.

The principals shall submit to the school board for approval any contracts, leases or purchases necessary to maintain and operate transportation equipment, and shall include in his or her annual report to the board information as to all pupils transported by the school district and the expense thereof.
